DO YOU QUALIFY?

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- Five (5) or more years of full time work experience
- Content area expertise, with a GPA of 2.5 or better in applicable courses
- Required assessments (Praxis II and VCLA)
- Criminal background check
- Do not currently have a Provisional License or expired Provisional License from the VDOE or a teaching license from any other state.

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- Complete the 16-week Level One program, which includes 30 hours of classroom experience
- Teach successfully with a provisional license for one full year prior to being recommended for a full 5-year renewable teaching license
- Complete Level Two of the program during the 1-year provisional period, which includes Saturday sessions and online training
